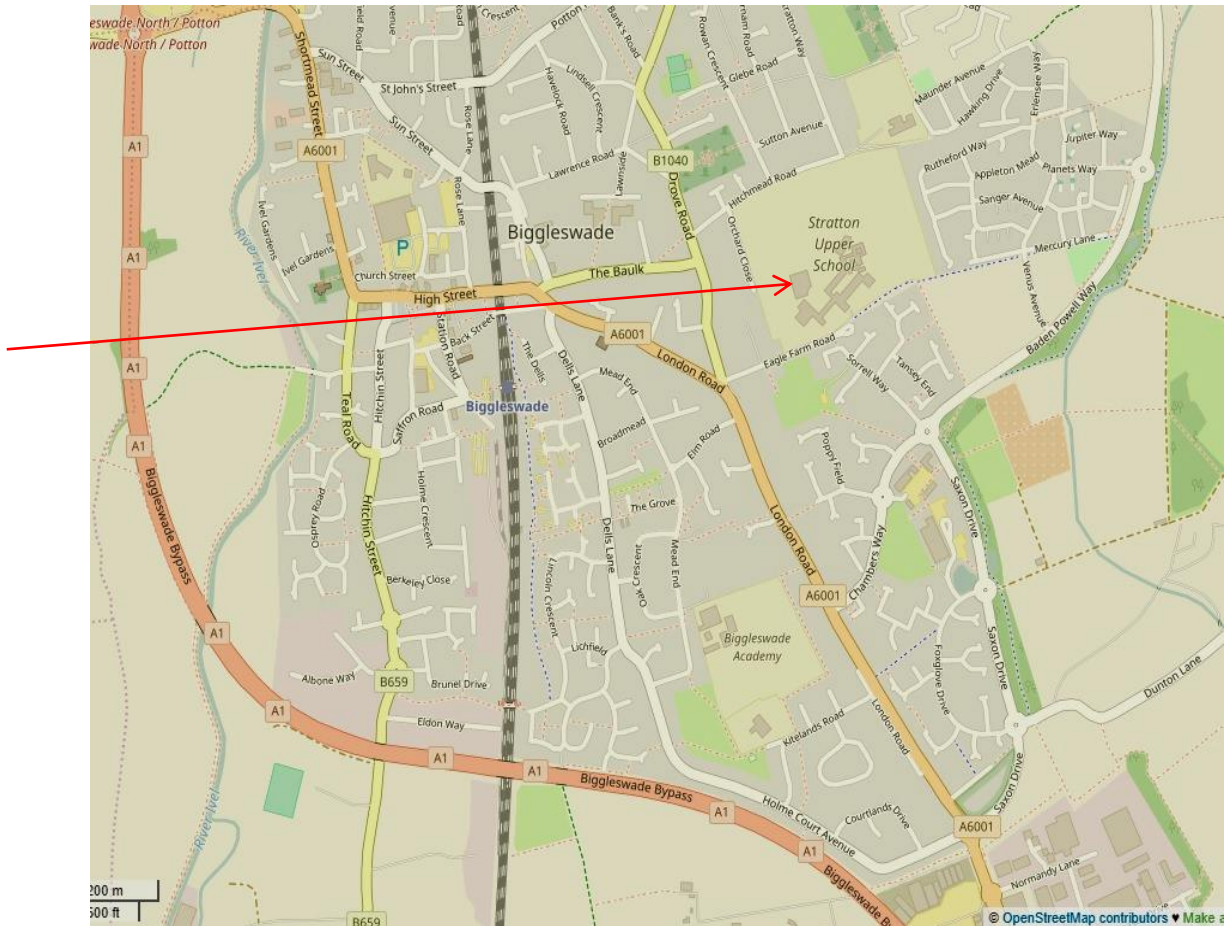

How to find the Weatherley Centre (post code: SG18 8JH)



Recommended route to avoid Town centre: Leave the A1 at the Biggleswade South roundabout, taking the 2nd exit - A6001 (London Rd). Continue on London Road through the next 3 roundabouts. After 0.7 miles turn right onto B1040, then immediately turn right onto Eagle Farm Road. Turn into Stratton school car park, pass the school buildings on your right, the Weatherley Centre is straight ahead and its car park is to the left of the building.

Note: Saturday is Market Day in Biggleswade, so if you are approaching from the North, you are advised to continue down the A1 to the Biggleswade South roundabout and not leave at the north exit.

By train: Biggleswade Railway Station is approx 15 mins walk
